### Rally info

Some things you need to know when visiting the International Rally in Holland:

There will be two entrances to the Rally, one for new arrivals, one for guests who already checked in. Please follow the appropriate sign at the gate.

At the campsite there are two separate fields. On the fields you must follow the directions of the 'Fieldmaster' at all times. He will show you where to put up your tent and where to park your bike.

All bikes must be parked in the secured parking area. For safety reasons no bikes are allowed to be parked on the field.

The portaloos on the field are only accessible from 22:00 at night till 09:00 in the morning.

When you leave the campsite there is a petrol station a few hundred meters to the right.

The ride out will start at 11:30 Saturday morning. Make sure you've got enough fuel before leaving on the ride out.
